Boy Scout Unit Requirements

1. All Leaders have current Youth Protection Training.
2. At least one adult on every outing has current Weather Awareness.
3. When activities are in or on the water, leaders have current Safe Swim Defense and/or Safety Afloat, whichever is appropriate to the activity.
4. On Hiking activities, the accompanying adults have current Trek Safely.
5. Adults providing transportation have signed a Safe Driver Pledge.
6. A well stocked Unit First Aid Kit is taken on all outings.
7. At least one leader on all outings has a cell phone or radio that has functional service in the area where any outing will take place.
8. At least 50% of Scouts have earned the First Aid Merit Badge.
9. All Scouts know their full name, address and telephone number and how to summon help in case of an emergency.
10. Scouts assist in performing an annual safety review of the place in which they meet, including where exits are located and what they should do in case of fire.
11. Leaders have access to the current Guide to Safe Scouting and review Proper safety guidelines for activities the Troop will engage in.
