



Suggested items to bring to camp:

- **Sleeping Bag/Sheets/Blanket**
- **Pillow**
- **Flashlight**
- **Personal Items (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap and other toiletries)**
- **Towel & Shower Shoes**
- **Extra Clothes/Socks/Shoes**
- **Rain Gear**
- **Insect Repellent**
- **Sunscreen**
- **Water Bottle**
- **Lawn Chairs**
- **Food/Drinks/Snacks - Note: The trading post will be open and has snacks and drinks**
- **Paper Products (plates, napkins, plastic utensils, etc.)**
- **Cooking Equipment**
- **Trash Bags**
- **Costumes**

The following rules are enforced at the Lawhorn Scouting Base:

- **No pets or other animals should be brought to camp (registered service animals permitted).**
- **Alcoholic beverages and illicit substances are prohibited.**
- **No fires or other heat sources are allowed in tents, adirondacks, cabins or any other camp structure.**
- **All vehicles must be parked in one of the camp parking lots.**
- **No one may ride in the back of a truck or trailer; seat belts must be worn by anyone in a moving vehicle.**
- **The speed limit in camp is 9 mph. Pedestrians always have the right of way.**
- **Closed-toed shoes must be worn at all times. Sandals may only be worn at the showers.**
- **Two-deep leadership is required at all times for youth. BSA Youth Protection guidelines must be practiced; leaders and parents must be trained.**
- **Bicycles are not permitted.**
- **All fuel for lanterns, stoves, etc. must be handled only by adults. Fuel must be secured and locked away.**
- **No firearms or any kind of ammunition are allowed.**
- **Fireworks are prohibited.**
