

Suggested items to bring to camp:

- Sleeping Bag/Sheets/Blanket
- Pillow
- Flashlight
- Personal Items (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap and other toiletries)
- Towel & Shower Shoes
- Extra Clothes/Socks/Shoes
- Rain Gear
- Insect Repellent
- Sunscreen
- Water Bottle
- Lawn Chairs
- Food/Drinks/Snacks Note: The trading post will be open and has snacks and drinks
- Paper Products (plates, napkins, plastic utensils, etc.)
- Cooking Equipment
- Trash Bags
- Costumes

The following rules are enforced at the Lawhorn Scouting Base:

- No pets or other animals should be brought to camp (registered service animals permitted).
- Alcoholic beverages and illicit substances are prohibited.
- No fires or other heat sources are allowed in tents, adirondacks, cabins or any other camp structure.
- All vehicles must be parked in one of the camp parking lots.
- No one may ride in the back of a truck or trailer; seat belts must be worn by anyone in a moving vehicle.
- The speed limit in camp is 9 mph. Pedestrians always have the right of way.
- Closed-toed shoes must be worn at all times. Sandals may only be worn at the showers.
- Two-deep leadership is required at all times for youth. BSA Youth Protection guidelines must be practiced; leaders and parents must be trained.
- Bicycles are not permitted.
- All fuel for lanterns, stoves, etc. must be handled only by adults. Fuel must be secured and locked away.
- No firearms or any kind of ammunition are allowed.
- Fireworks are prohibited.
